## Why get Babysitter Certified?

American Allstars Babysitter's Training and Certification will provide youth (ages 10-14) who are planning to babysit with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly provide basic child care for children and infants; including diapering, feeding, and clothing. This training will help participants to develop an understanding of behavior, create an environment that is fun and safe, keep themselves and others safe when babysitting, and build problem solving skills that will assist in making responsible and appropriate decisions. Trainees will also learn about basic first aid, such as hand washing, choking, and caring for minor injuries. *Includes Red Cross Babysitter Student Kit!*

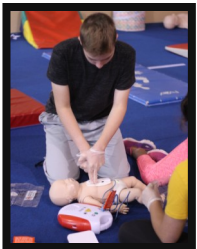

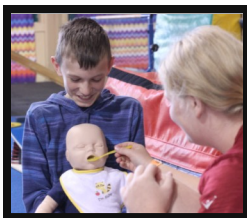
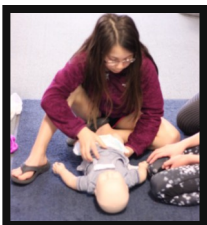
